FOOD VENDOR RULES & REGULATIONS

- Vendor selection will be determined using the following criteria: A) First paid first selected B)
 Seneca Preference C) Number of available spaces dedicated to any one type of vendor.
- 2. All traders MUST be Native American (Federally Recognized Tribes only). Include a copy of Tribal Enrollment Certification with Vendor Application.
- 3. If you application is not accepted, your fee will be sent back to you.
- 4. NO CAMPING PERMITTED ON POW WOW GROUNDS. Free camping/showers at Allegany Community Center: 777 Allegany Blvd, Salamanca, NY 14779.
- 5. COST: \$300.00 provide own tables, chairs and canopy space is 20' x 20'
- 6. Each vendor will be provided with 6 weekend pass bracelets. A \$10 fee will be charged for each additional bracelet above the allotted number per site.
- 7. Payment must be made in full by July 1st, 2014 in U.S. funds only
- 8. Dancers, drum groups and Pow Wow Committee members will be given \$5 food vouchers. They are to be treated as cash. When you close for business, come to the registration table to redeem your vouchers for cash. "Dancers/drummers ONLY" line must be established during dinner break to accommodate them.
- 9. Once you are notified you are selected to be a vendor, your registration becomes non-refundable. All fees are non-transferable.

SET UP

- 10. Grounds will be open for vendor set up during following times: Thurs 9am-7pm & Friday 8-1pm
- 11. Grounds will be open for community on Friday @ 4pm. FREE ADMISSION. Grand Entry is scheduled on Friday evening.
- 12. Only supply vehicles & utility trailers will be allowed to park on the perimeters of the food vendor area. Specific areas will be set aside for vendors. Parking map available in June on website.
- 13. ALL confirmed vendors must check in with Heath Garlow upon arrival for assigned spot.
- 14. You must supply your own power cords 12/3; ALL power cords MUST BE 16 GAUGE.
- 15. Vendors must provide their own NSF standard water hose to connect to water source.
- 16. Vendors MUST be set up and open for business by 10:00am both Saturday and Sunday.
- 17. Bags of ice will be made available to all food vendors at a nominal cost.
- 18. All food vendors must comply with Seneca Nation Health System regulations. Inspectors will be stopping at each booth once a day. Non-compliant vendors will have an opportunity to correct violation if there are any. If you refuse to correct, or are unable to correct, you will be asked to close.

Decisions regarding the vendor's rules & regulations determined by the Pow Wow Committee are final. Neither the Pow Wow Committee or associated partners and/or affiliates are responsible for lost or stolen items, personal damages or personal injuries which may occur during the Pow Wow.
