2018 CRAFT VENDOR RULES & REGULATIONS

- 1. Vendor selection will be determined by the following criteria: A) Seneca Preference B) First paid first selected C) Number of available spaces dedicated to any one type of vendor.
- 2. All vendors MUST be enrolled in a federally recognized Tribe/Nation. Proof of enrollment required.
- 3. You must understand that filling out the application is just that...an application...not a registration form. Please do not consider yourself registered until notified as such. The onus is on you to find out the status of your application.
- 4. If your application is not accepted, the already deposited fee will be refunded via check.
- 5. NO CAMPING PERMITTED ON POW WOW GROUNDS. Free Camping/showers available at the Allegany Community Center: 777 Allegany Blvd, Salamanca, NY 14779.
- 6. COST: \$250.00. We provide only a 20' x 20' space. You provide your own tables, chairs and canopy, etc.
- 7. We will have 4 spaces available this year along the fence where vendors will be able to have a trailer as part of their 20x20 vendor space. Those dedicated spaces are the only place trailers will be permitted. If you wish to be placed in one of these 4 spaces, please indicate so on application.
- 8. Each vendor will be provided three weekend pass bracelets and must be worn at all times.
- 9. No fundraising to be conducted in the crafters booths. Fundraising limited to the non-profit spaces only.
- 10. A "Complete Application" consists of: completed application form, payment in full (US funds), and proof of enrollment. The complete application deadline is June 22, 2018.
- 11. Once you are notified that you are selected to be a vendor, your registration fee becomes non-refundable.

 All fees are non-transferable.
- 12. We welcome \$20(+) value craft items as donations for Veterans prizes in the Veterans Welcoming Tent.

SET UP

- 13. Pow Wow grounds will be open for vendor set up: Thursday 9am-7pm, Fri: 8am-1pm.
- 14. Grounds open to the public at 4pm Friday. Grand Entry is scheduled on Friday evening.
- 15. Vehicles are not allowed in the craft vendor area for more than one hour. Volunteer help will be provided to unload during said hour. This is to unload and load ONLY. Parking map available in June on website.
- 16. ALL confirmed vendors must check in with Heath Garlow by 11:00 am Friday for assigned spot.
- 17. Vehicles will not be allowed on the powwow grounds after 1:00 pm on Friday. Safety First!!

INTEGRITY

- 18. NO smoking, NO pets, NO drugs, NO alcohol permitted in the park.
- 19. ONLY quality Native American goods may be sold (e.g. no product from China or Mexico).
- 20. No Tobacco, False Face, or Snapping Turtle Rattles, or any item that is part of any tribe's ceremonial or sacred event may be knowingly allowed to be sold as such.
- 21. Decisions regarding the vendor rules and regulations determined by the PowWow Committee are final.
- **22.** Neither the PowWow Committee, nor associated partners and/or affiliates are responsible for lost or stolen items, personal damages or personal injuries which may occur during the powwow.
