2022 Non-Profit Booth Rules & Regulations

- 1. Vendor selection will be determined by the following criteria: A) Seneca Preference B) Number of available spaces dedicated to any one type of vendor C) Booth is dedicated to veterans' concerns D) First apply, first selected.
- 2. All applicants are subject to committee approval, and that approval can be revoked by the committee for any reason deemed necessary at any time before, or during, the powwow.
- 3. Raffle tickets are the only items that may be sold at a Non-Profit stand. This type of booth that will require proof of enrollment.
- 4. Only three booths selling raffle tickets will be accepted. The rest will be informational booths.
- 5. No school organizations, Kindergarten through twelfth grade, will be allowed to sell raffle tickets or exchange money in any way.
- 6. Organizations applying for a booth that are informational ONLY can be from any community, municipality, or interest (other than a public school).
- 7. Any non-profit organization that intends to sell anything (other than raffle tickets) must apply to be a Vendor (craft or food, never both) and though they are a Non-profit organization, are no longer subject to "Non-Profit Rules and Regulations", but rather become subject to the rules governing that type of vendor for which they are applying.
- 8. All non-profit organization wishing to be a food AND a craft vendor, must submit two separate applications; one per type of application, and be subject to the same rules governing that type of selection criteria for those vendor applications. (Food/Craft sales do not qualify for the non-profit booth)
- 9. If you are applying only for certain days, then please indicate the desired days on the application. This will increase the number of organizations that can be accepted.
- 10. One weekend bracelet per booth will be allowed, with no parking pass.
- 11. NO CAMPING PERMITTED ON POW WOW GROUNDS. Free Camping/showers available at the Allegany Community Center: 3677 Administration Drive, Salamanca, NY 1477.
- 12. We provide only a 10' x 10' space. You provide your own tables, chairs and canopy, etc. [MUST BRING OWN WEIGHTS, NO STAKES]
- 13. NO smoking, NO pets, NO drugs, NO alcohol permitted in the park.

SET UP

- 14. No vehicles are allowed on the powwow grounds while the powwow is in session.
- 15. Grand Entry is scheduled on Saturday and Sunday at noon.
- 16. ALL confirmed Non-Profits must check in with Vendor Coordinator for assigned spot.
- 17. No electric or water will be provided for Non-Profit booths.
- 18. Non-Profit booths MUST be set up and open by 10 AM. This is for safety of all powwow patrons.
- 19. Decisions regarding these rules and regulations are determined by the Powwow Committee are final.
- 20. Neither the Powwow Committee, nor associated partners and/or affiliates are responsible for lost or stolen items, personal damages or personal injuries which may occur during the powwow.
